## Our Outcome Summary:

- Provided 2 workshop sessions
- Provided 1 follow up visit for the employees who were unable to attend workshops
- Reached 20 people
- Prior to our outreach, 100% were unfamiliar with Wheels of Dreams
- Prior to our outreach 100% were unfamiliar with the Wheels of Dreams scholarships
- Prior to our outreach 80% were unfamiliar with Archways
- To date, 4 attendees have requested the Wheels of Dreams program at their schools
- 6 employees have requested to apply for Archways
- 10 attendees learned how to apply and prepare for scholarship process
- 6 plan to apply for our scholarships next year
- 5 requested applications to apply for scholarships this year
